Introduction

These rules set out the conditions and procedures for obtaining, maintaining and terminating membership in the Consortium Diplomatique Europée (CDE). The aim is to provide clear rules for admission, obligations and rights of members and the method of exclusion in the event of non-compliance with the rules of the Organisation.

Conditions For Membership

Membership is open to individuals who support the objectives and values of the Organisation.

The candidate must submit a completed application form and all required documents.

The candidate must pass the AML/KYC security check and pay the associated fee.

The candidate must pay the registration fee and regularly pay the membership fee for first year of membership.

The member must comply with the statutes and rules of the Organisation.

Member Admission Procedure

An existing CDE member submits a proposal for admission of a new member. The CDE Organisation provides the candidate with a presentation of the activities and general information.

If the candidate accepts the conditions, the candidate sends the completed application form and documentation.

An AML/KYC verification process is carried out.

After successful verification, the candidate pays the application fee and membership fee.

The organization issues membership documents (e.g. diplomatic card DID, vehicle registration, etc., where appropriate according to his/her status).

Member Rights

Members of the Organization shall have the following rights and benefits:

- The right to participate in meetings and events of the Organization.
- The right to propose and vote on important decisions of the Organization.
- Access to internal resources and benefits offered by the Organization to members.
- The right to diplomatic status (where appropriate and in accordance with the terms of membership).
- The possibility of participating in humanitarian and logistical projects of the Organization.
- The right to legal assistance within the Organization (if specified by the Organization's rules).

Member Duties

Members shall have the following duties:

- Regular payment of membership fees and other financial obligations.
- Respect for the statute, rules and values of the organization.
- Active participation in the activities of the organization.
- Maintaining the organization's reputation in public.
- Informing the organization about any changes to personal data.
- Exploitation of membership for personal gain, abuse of status or disregard of laws is unacceptable.

Financial Obligations Of Members

Each member must pay the entrance fee and membership fee upon entry.

Membership fees are determined according to the type of membership and are paid annually.

Failure to pay the membership fee within the specified period may lead to suspension or expulsion.

Membership Renewal

Members must renew their membership no later than 30 days before the expiration of their existing membership.

Failure to renew their membership by the deadline may lead to automatic expulsion.

Diplomatic Status And Withdrawal Of Privileges

If a member receives a Diplomatic Passport or other privileges, the organization may revoke them in the event of:

- Violation of the laws of the host country,
- Failure to comply with the rules of the organization,
- Actions that harm the reputation of the organization.

Honorary Membership

Honorary membership is awarded to persons who have significantly contributed to the development of the organization. Honorary members are exempt from membership fees, but do not have voting rights.

Responsibility Of The Organization To Members

The organization is not responsible for illegal or unethical activities of individuals if they act outside the framework of its rules.

Termination Of Membership

Membership terminates in the following cases:

- Voluntary withdrawal: A member may submit a written statement of withdrawal at any time.
- Non-payment of membership fees: If a member fails to settle his/her obligations within the specified period, he/she shall be automatically excluded after a written warning.

- Disciplinary exclusion: In the event of serious violations of the Organization's rules or inappropriate behavior, a member may be excluded by decision of the disciplinary committee.
- Death of a member.

In the event of termination of membership in CDE, membership rights are not transferred to potential successors.

Final Provisions

Each member must sign a declaration that they are aware of these regulations. These regulations enter into force on the date of adoption.

Any changes to these regulations must be approved by the President of the Organization (executive committee of the organization).

With these regulations, the Consortium Diplomatique Européen provides clear membership conditions and procedures that support the Organization's operations and its values.
